



## Waldorf University Education Program Progression

### Early academic work – establishing eligibility to apply for the Teacher Education Program

- Earned C- or higher in EDU 201 – Intro to Teaching
- Passed EDU 202 – Intro to Teaching Clinical
- Earned C or higher in ENG 121, Composition II (or ENG 106 – Honors Comp. I)
- Completed a Mathematics course, MTH 101 or higher, earning a C-or higher
- Completed or enrolled in PSY 144 – Human Growth and Development

### Additional steps

- Complete at least 12.5 hours of Community Service (suggested pace for 1 yr. at Waldorf)
- Submit completed documents within the Teacher Education Program application packet
- Education courses to take within the next year: EDU 240 – Educational Psychology (offered in both Fall and Spring semesters) and SPED 220 – Exceptional Learners (offered in Fall only)
- Establish at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA in Education courses

### Acceptance to Teacher Education Program allows you to register for Methods courses.

**EDU 350 for Elementary and EDU 395 for Secondary and K-12 candidates can be taken prior to full acceptance to the Teacher Education Program.**

#### Additional courses to take:

EDU 230 – Ed. Media – all candidates  
EDU 400 – Ethics & Religious Diversity – all candidates (Jr./Sr.)  
EDU 253 – Literature for Children – Elementary candidates

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Earn B- or higher in Methods courses</li><li>• Earn C- or higher in Education Core and content courses</li><li>• Maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative Education GPA</li><li>• Continue earning and documenting community service hours (12.5 hours per full-time semester as a Waldorf Education major)</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Successfully complete any Progress Evaluation Plans of Action that were prescribed for you</li><li>• Apply to student teach one year prior to planned student teaching semester</li><li>• Complete EDU 411 – Multicultural Practicum one to two semesters prior to student teaching</li><li>• Apply for Iowa teaching license during your student teaching/Capstone semester</li></ul> |
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### Recommendation for Licensure will occur upon successful completion of:

- Student teaching and Capstone
- All state requirements
- All program and institutional requirements, including Community Service hours and exit form
