## DO NOT BRING

- // Air conditioner
- // Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances or drug paraphernalia, empty alcoholic beverage containers or other prohibited decorative containers
- // Anything that would be a fire hazard (candles, incense, halogen lamps and lava lamps)
- // Appliances with an open heating element or fire hazards (toasters, toaster oven, hot plates, steam cookers, electric skillets, woks, foreman grill)
- // Firecrackers/fireworks
- // Hanging items that would damage walls or ceilings (nails, screws, tape, glue)
- // Homemade lofts
- // Hub or router
- // Pets (except fish in a 10-gallon tank or less)
- // Space heater
- // Tobacco & vaping products (including e-cigarettes)
- // Valuables
- // Video camera for room
- // Weapons of any kind (e.g. tasers, BB/pellet guns, splat guns or toy guns)

## PLANNING TO WORK ON OR OFF CAMPUS?

Employers need identification to complete an I-9 form. Acceptable documents could include the following:

- // U.S. Passport, U.S. Passport Card or foreign passport with Form I-94 or Form I94A with Arrival-Departure Record, and containing an endorsement to work
- // Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- // Foreign passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa
- // Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
- // ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies or entities provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, sex, height, eye color and address
- // School ID card with a photograph
- // Voter's registration card
- // U.S. Military card, draft record or Military dependent's ID card
- // U.S. Social Security Card
- // Certification of report of birth issued by Department of State
- // Original or certified copy of birth certificate
- // Native American tribal document
- // U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
- // Identification Card for Use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)
