Waldorf University - Officially Non-Profit!!



Waldorf University is proud to announce that the U.S. Department of Education has approved Waldorf's request to convert to nonprofit status. This is the final step of the process since the Higher Learning Commission, the IRS, and the State of Iowa had previously approved the Change in Ownership.

The nonprofit status granted by the U.S. Department of Education marks a pivotal moment in Waldorf's ongoing efforts to further its educational and social impact. The new status enables the university to expand its research capacity, enhance partnerships with community organizations, and improve student services while maintaining its commitment to reinvesting resources into its educational programs and mission.

"We are thrilled to receive this approval, as it allows us to broaden our impact in ways that will directly benefit our students, faculty, and the communities we serve," said Robert Alsop, President of Waldorf University. "This nonprofit status empowers us to focus even more on our core mission of providing an inclusive and affordable educational experience that drives success and opportunity for all."

This milestone is part of a broader strategy by Waldorf University to continually enhance its educational offerings, expand its reach, and build stronger relationships with industry, government, and nonprofit sectors. Waldorf is committed to fostering an environment where academic excellence, personal growth, and community development go hand in hand.

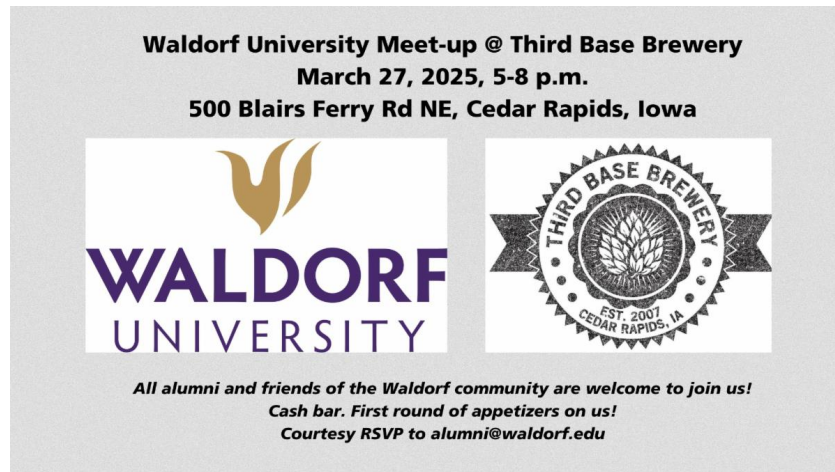
